Rebuilding Together Alexandria, Sears and Kmart Give Local Resident a Ride

Local Resident Benefits from the Heroes at Homesm Program

Alexandria, Va. - March 3, 2008 - Rebuilding Together Alexandria recently repaired and improved the homes of four local veterans of World War II and the Korean War as part of the Heroes at Homesm program. The Heroes at Homesm program helps Alexandria veterans and their survivors, and many others around the country live independently in their own homes in safety and comfort. The lift will now enable Ms. Carrie to 'ride' upstairs and sleep in her own bedroom, something she has not been able to do since having her right leg amputated. Ms. Carrie exclaimed, "I can't thank you enough for the lift. I can't wait to go upstairs again. What a great Valentine's Day present." Mayor Euille was on hand to help Ms. Carrie take her first ride on the new chair lift.
